Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Adjusting curriculum for and conducting research around age-appropriate material.
- In-classroom teaching for groups of 9-25 students. (Group size varies depending on program site and larger class sizes are possible.)
- Aid in facilitating the collection of impact data, testimonials, and assessments.
- Reviewing and editing of all POL materials that may be shared with various program sites, funders, etc.
- Availability before each day of the project to touch base about upcoming lessons.
- Consulting with the POL team to gauge success and areas for growth after the completion of each project.
